

## List of possible sources of funding

We provide here a non-exhaustive list of international sources of funding where the organizers of CIMPA Schools should apply to complete the CIMPA support:

- International Mathematical Union (IMU):

- Agence Universitaire de la Francophonie (AUF): Organizers are advised to apply for funding from AUF. For this, they should contact the representative of AUF in the region where the school is held, see <https://www.auf.org>
- Embassies: Each school will be announced to the Embassy of France (or Norway, Spain, Switzerland, provided citizens of those countries are involved in the school) in the country by an official letter sent by CIMPA. In this way, the organizers will be able to contact the representative of the Embassy in charge of scientific cooperation to apply for support.
- Laboratoires internationaux associés (LIA) and Groupements de recherche internationaux de CNRS: Organizers are encouraged to contact the directors of LIA and GDRI of CNRS in the region for support, see <http://www.cnrs.fr/insmi/spip.php?rubrique59>

- If the external coordinator is member of INRIA, he/she can ask for a support from INRIA for the school after consulting the DRI at [dri-rocq@inria.fr](mailto:dri-rocq@inria.fr). With the agreement of the head of his/her team, the full trip of any participant from INRIA can be covered by INRIA.
- To support organizers and instructors affiliated to German institutions, the Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF) plans to provide subsidies for travel expenses to CIMPA Schools.
